LOCATION

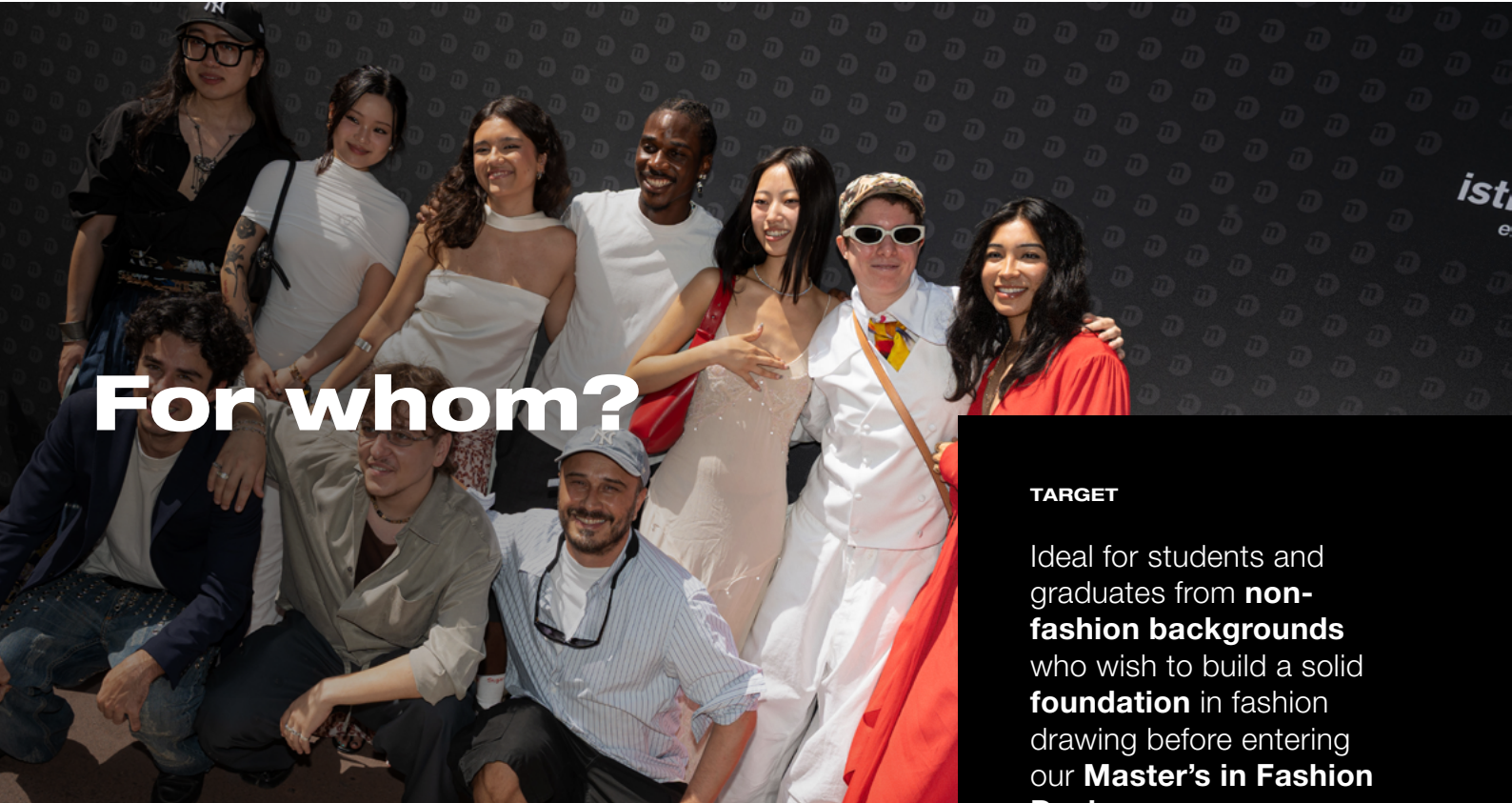
Milan is the international **Capital of Fashion, Accessories, Design** and **Beauty** where key players in Luxury converge.

FUNDAMENTAL DRAWING SKILLS

Build fundamental drawing skills and techniques for fashion illustration, learning how to observe, analyse, and translate the human figure into expressive sketches.

MATERIALS AND TECHNIQUES

Explore the use of pencils and markers to accurately represent fabrics, textures, and silhouettes, developing sensitivity to proportion, movement, and detail.

DIGITAL ILLUSTRATION

Explore different drawing methods and media to Get introduced to digital tools and creative workflows using Procreate, discovering how to merge traditional techniques with contemporary digital illustration practices.

PERSONAL VISUAL LANGUAGE

Develop a personal visual language that reflects your creative identity, through continuous practice in both analog and digital media.



Develop your creative voice through fashion illustration — from pencil to procreate, discover how to turn ideas into expressive visual concepts.

Week 1

Foundations of drawing.

You will begin by exploring the basics of line, proportion, and anatomy through practical drawing exercises. Our faculty will guide you in observational sketching and gestural drawing to capture movement and attitude. This week builds the essential confidence to represent the human figure accurately and expressively.

Week 2

Rendering Fabrics and Textures.

You will experiment with markers, coloured pencils, and mixed media to bring garments to life. Through hands-on demonstrations, you will learn to render light, shadow, and material qualities such as silk, denim, and wool. This week emphasizes colour theory and the translation of fabric behaviour into dynamic illustrations.

Week 3

Digital Drawing & Visual Expression.

You will transition from paper to tablet, applying your traditional skills in Procreate. Through step-by-step digital workshops, you will learn to build layers, adapt textures, and compose professional fashion illustrations. The course concludes with a final small project that showcases your personal style and creative growth.



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
