

1. Sign up


Have a personal email address or the IDs of your establishment.

2. Apply and visit

Detail your criteria in the search bar to find accommodation that meets your needs. As soon as you like an accommodation, apply by writing a message to the owner. Online or remotely, visit the accommodation.

3. Book

Book online by paying your first month's rent and platform fees. Platform fees vary between between 175 and 400€ depending on the city, the type of accommodation. They make it possible to finance the support, the verification of the advertisements and to bring you assistance in the event of a glitch.





Before booking your accomodation

Create your rental file


In France, all rental companies ask for a rental file. It allows them to find out about your situation and check whether your profile meets their expectations, in particular by terms of solvency (your ability to pay your rent). On Studapart you compile your file once for all your applications.

In my documents, you just need to download:

- 1. your identity document front / back (a photo is also possible)
- 2. proof of your admission/registration in your institution (an email from your school also works)

Documents from your guarantor:

- 1. his identity document
- 2. his last 3 payslips
- 3. his tax notice

Studapart acts as guarantor for you throughout the duration of your rental. It's this way.

2_{.2} Start your research at the right time

When looking for accommodation, the key word is: anticipation. The earlier you get there, the better the odds in your favour. To not miss any news, subscribe to the email alert: you will receive accommodations adapted to your criteria on a daily basis.

1. Apply as soon as you like an accommodation


On average, you have to make 7 requests before finding the right accommodation..

2. Put the odds on your side by polishing your presentation

With a rental file completed on the platform (renters love it) and a neat presentation message.

3. The lessor has no visibility on the next availability,

position yourself on the waiting list. Often rental companies do not have visibility for more than a month because they are waiting for their former tenants to confirm their desire to leave.



2.3 No guarantor? Studapart vouches for you

A guarantor is someone close to you (relative, friend, etc.) or an organization (e.g. Studapart) who recognizes that you are a reliable and solvent person, i.e. able to pay the rent..




If you do not have a Guarantor, Studapart can act as guarantor for you throughout the duration of your rental

There are two possible solutions for this:

- 1. Either you subscribe directly to the Guaranteed Profile
- 2. Either you leave your file as it is, and if the lessor considers that your income is not substantial enough, he can then send you a reservation proposal that includes the guarantee.

The guaranteed profile



1. Login


Connect to Studapart and go to >> menu >> Guaranteed Profile.

2. Activate service

Once the service is activated, a badge appears on your profile and the renters see that your profile is verified and validated by Studapart. Your Guaranteed Profile remains active for 6 months from the day of subscription.

3. Benefit from the Guarantee free of charge






2_{.4} Visit!

In person or remotely, here are the things to check when you visit.



- 1. Is the information on the ad correct?
- 2. Do I like the neighborhood? If you are remote, find out on internet.
- 3. Have I correctly identified all housing costs?



A doubt about an ad before or after the visit, let us know!

2_{.5} Draw up your rental contract

You can sign it remotely at the time of booking before you enter the premises with a scan, or directly on the day of the entry inventory.

You decide with your landlord when you want to sign it: if you need to provide proof of address to obtain a visa, you can of course sign it remotely, once your reservation has been confirmed.

The lease (or rental contract) is a written document listing all the information necessary for the rental to run smoothly. There are several types of leases. For example, the contract is not the same depending on whether the accommodation is rented furnished or unfurnished.





2_{.6} Take out home insurance


It is compulsory to insure your accommodation: your landlord will ask you for an insurance certificate when you enter the premises. Find out what you need to know about rates, clauses and the procedure for declaring a claim.


Simple home insurance



4.1 Does Studapart manage the payment of other rents?

Studapart only manages the first rent. It will be automatically paid to your landlord via the platform, the first day after your entry date. It's a way to protect yourself in case something goes wrong. Indeed, if you wish to cancel or if the accommodation has a problem, we can refund your rent.

For the following months, bank transfers must be made directly to the owner.

What concrete protections does Studapart x my school provide?

In addition to checking the profile of the lessors, Studapart x Ecole provides you with 3 key protections:

1. Protection against last-minute cancellations:

if the landlord no longer wishes to rent his accommodation to you at the last minute, Studapart will find you a temporary solution and help you find new accommodation.

2. Protection against non-compliant ads: within 24 hours of entering the premises, if you notice a major non-compliance of the accommodation with the description, you can cancel your reservation and be reimbursed within 24 hours.

3. **Protection against bad behavior:** if the owner does not behave well before entering the premises, you can cancel your reservation and be reimbursed within 24 hours.

The problems encountered must be reported to Studapart before the lease is taken.

What do I have to pay to finalize my online reservation?

When booking, you will automatically be asked to pay online:

- 1. The first month's rent
- 2. Studapart fees

Optional, at the lessor's request

1. The Studapart Guarantee

What is the Studapart Guarantee

The Studapart Guarantee is optional, at the request of the lessor to protect him from unpaid rent if you do not have a guarantor. This Warranty is your responsibility.



4.2 Understand the lexicon of housing

What are the different types of housing?

A T1 (or F1) accommodation

It is a one-room housing. Which is a living room used both as a living room and a bedroom.

A T2 apartment

A T2 apartment is simply a housing that contains two rooms. It is usually a living room (or living room) and a bedroom.

A T3 accommodation

A T3 accommodation (or F3 when it comes to a house) contains three rooms: a living room (or living room) and two bedrooms.

A T4 accommodation

A T4 apartment, which is a main room and three bedrooms, is ideal for several people to settle in and thus reduce the costs of shared accommodation (rent, charges, appendices...).

A studio

A studio is a housing that consists of only one room. This serves both as a bedroom and a living room, what is called a "living room".

What is the homestay?

It allows the student to stay in their own room but under the same roof as a family or an elderly couple, for example.

What is co-loving?

The principle of coliving is both flatsjare and coworking. It combines housing and work, but also community life and home, in the same place.

What are rental charges?

The charges are paid in addition to the rent. They must therefore appear separately from the rent, in the form of a "rent + charges" breakdown. The charges are for example water, electricity, heating, internet...

What are housing benefits?

The Family Allowance Fund, or CAF

It is this body that is responsible for paying eligible tenants housing assistance.
Personalized Housing Assistance, or APL.

This is the most commonly paid aid among housing aids.



4_{.3} Student life tips

- Your monthly subscriptions (internet, telephone, electricity, public transport, etc.)
- Your meals
- Your hobbies (cinema, sport, exhibitions, etc).

Manage your student budget

Your contribution to student and campus life (C.V.E.C.)
This contribution of €92 is compulsory each year by students in initial training, including distance learning, in a higher education establishment. It makes it possible to better welcome students and to offer them social, health, cultural and sporting support during their studies. International exchange students are exempt from this contribution.

To adjust your C.V.E.C:

Register on the website messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr
Then connect to the dedicated website cvec.etudiant.gouv.fr

Social security in France

Affiliation to social security is free and compulsory for all students in France, whether you are French or foreign. Social security covers part of your health expenses.

Focus on the French health system

- 1. If you are a French student: you are automatically registered. No steps to take for you!
- 2. If you are an international student: you must register as soon as your registration in your institution is validated. Unless you were already enrolled in a French school this year. Go to etudiant-etranger.ameli.fr
- 3. If you are a European student, you must register if you do not have a European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or if you have a form.

 S1*. If you have an EHIC or are already registered in a French establishment this year, you do not need to register.



To know!

Your EHIC must be valid until the end of the academic year for you to be reimbursed for your healthcare costs. The EHIC concerns the member countries of the European Union, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland.

*The S1 form

Portable document which is requested in your country, before leaving, with the health organization where you are affiliated. It allows you to register for social security in France. The S1 form is only for citizens of EU/EEA/Swiss countries.

You can also subscribe to complementary health insurance: mutual insurance. It allows you to complete the reimbursement of your health expenses, which are reimbursed at 60% by social security.
