Marcella Bricchi is programme leader of the Interior design department, for which she structures the courses, and is a teacher of Interiors at the Istituto Marangoni, combining her unique approach from her education as a fashion designer, which she pursued at the Istituto Marangoni itself, with her previous education in interior architecture in Pavia.

In the 80s, she worked in fashion as the principal designer for the noted international designer Jean Baptiste Caumont in the realization of his women's and men's collections for ready-to-wear, sportswear and couture for the US and Mexican markets. She has been a design consultant for the collections of various companies (Mirò-Milano, Ardizzone-Biella, Netz Corporation-Osaka, Tabarro-Basilea, Cappellificio Cervo-Biella), from clothing to accessories.

She has been a teacher of Fashion design, Textile design and Home collection at Istituto Marangoni and of the master courses "Gestion y Direccion de Diseno y Moda" at the University of Santiago de Compostela. She writes the monthly feature article "Abitare" on exceptional living spaces for the Italian magazine Oltre. She has worked on residential and commercial interior projects in Italy and the United States and she is part of the team "Inside", which focuses on interior architecture with both a technical and emotional approach.
